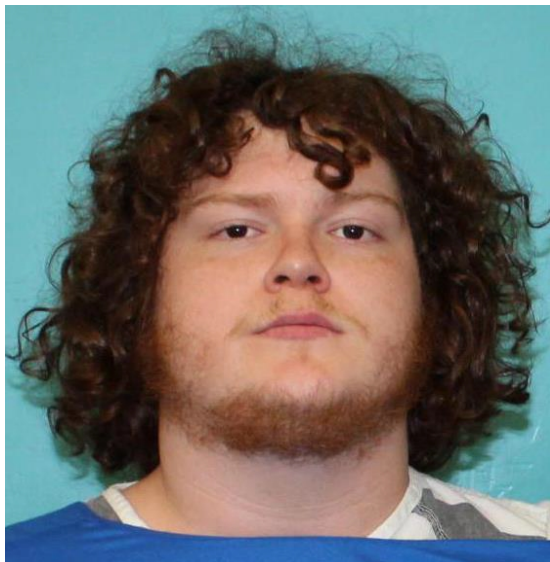
### **MEDIA RELEASE**

#### **ALLEN POLICE DEPARTMENT MAKES ARRESTS IN SHOOTING CASE**

On Monday evening January 6, 2020., at approximately 4:41 PM Parker Police and Allen Police received a shots fired call from the 1400 block of South Allen Heights Drive. The victim, a 19 year of age male Plano resident, who was riding a bicycle N/B on Allen Heights Drive reported that he heard what sounded like gun shots and felt something strike his right arm and leg. Approximately one minute before the male was struck a motorist reported that his SUV was struck in the driver side rear door with a bullet also on South Allen Heights Drive. No one in the SUV was injured. The victim was transported to the Medical Center of Plano where he was treated and released late last night.

On 01/09/2020 at approximately 5:30 PM the Allen Police Department arrested Tristion Morris B/M 09/12/1997 of Allen for Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon and Deadly Conduct. At approximately the same time the Dallas Police Department arrested Phillip Miller W/M 12/30/1998 of Dallas for Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon and Deadly Conduct. These arrested persons are both involved in the shooting criminal episode that occurred on Monday January 6, 2020 at approximately 4:41 PM in the 1400 block of South Allen Heights Drive. This is an ongoing investigation and more charges may follow. The Parker Police Department and the Allen Police Department would like to thank all the citizens that provided tips and information related to this incident.
