#### **UPDATE**

On October 14, 2020 at 8:29 pm, Felipe Ordonez W/M 06/25/2010 was pronounced deceased at Medical City Dallas Hospital from injuries sustained in the accident that occurred on October 13, 2020 on East Parker Road. Community support for the Ordonez family has been strong and the City of Parker has agreed to be a collection point for donations. Citizens wishing to donate to the Ordonez family can drop off donations at Parker City Hall during normal business hours.

#### **SERIOUS BODILY INJURY MOTOR VEHICLE CRASH**

On October 13, 2020 at 6:47 pm Parker Police Department and Parker Fire Department assisted by the Murphy Police Department and a Wylie Fire Department Ambulance, responded to a pedestrian struck by a motor vehicle accident in the intersection of 6400 East Parker Road at 4100 Andy's Lane.

Emergency personnel arrived to find a 10-year-old WH/M (resident of Parker, Texas) was struck by a red Ford F-150 pick-up driven westbound by a 35-year-old W/M of McKinney, Texas in the outside lane of 6400 East Parker Road. The 10-year-old victim was transported by ambulance to Medical City Dallas and is in stable but critical condition. This accident is currently under investigation. At this time, speed is not considered a factor and no criminal charges are anticipated as a result of this accident investigation.
